The Committee on Finance and Tax (Altman) recommended the following:

Senate Amendment (with title amendment)

Between lines 36 and 37 insert:

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(e) To qualify for a refund of tax pursuant to this subsection, a commercial airline shall demonstrate that it has increased its average daily available seat capacity on flights that originate in the state capital and fly directly to a destination in this state, or that take off from a destination in this state and fly directly to the state capital. The increase must be at least 20 percent as measured by comparing the average daily seat capacity over a 30-day period to the



13 average daily seat capacity for the immediately subsequent 30-14 day period. In order to continue to qualify for a refund pursuant to this subsection, the airline must demonstrate on a 15 16 month-to-month basis that it has at least maintained such increased average daily available seat capacity. 17 18 19 ======== T I T L E A M E N D M E N T ========== And the title is amended as follows: 20 Delete line 11 2.1 22 and insert: 23 aviation grants; providing criteria for a commercial 24 airline to qualify for a refund of tax; providing an 25 effective date.
