The Committee on Commerce (Lynn) recommended the following:

Senate Substitute for Amendment (413848) (with title amendment)

Delete everything after the enacting clause and insert:

Section 1. (1) An environmental surcharge is imposed on each bottle of water sold in the amount of 6 percent of the sales price of each item, article, or group of items of or containing bottled water when sold at retail in this state.

(2) All moneys collected from the surcharge levied under this section shall be deposited into the Ecosystem Management and Restoration Trust Fund within the Department of Environmental Protection.

(3) The surcharge levied under this section shall be administered, collected, and enforced in the same manner as the tax imposed under s. 212.05.

Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2010.
