Section 2. Subsection (3) is added to section 381.00315, Florida Statutes, to read:

381.00315 Public health advisories; public health emergencies.—The State Health Officer is responsible for declaring public health emergencies and issuing public health advisories.

(3) To facilitate effective emergency management, when the United States Department of Health and Human Services contracts for the manufacturing and delivery of licensable products in



response to a public health emergency and the terms of the contract is made available to the states, the Department of Health shall accept funds provided by municipalities, counties, and other entities designated in the state emergency management plan required under s. 252.35(2)(a) for the purpose of participation in the contract. The Department of Health shall deposit those funds in the Grants and Donations Trust Fund within the Department of Health and expend those funds on behalf of the donor municipality, county, or other entity for the purchase of the licensable products made available under the contract.
