Senate Joint Resolution

A joint resolution proposing the creation of Sections 8 and 9 of Article IX and the creation of a new section in Article XII of the State Constitution to require that 70 percent of school district funding be expended for the purpose of supporting classroom instruction and prohibit any school district from paying its school administrative personnel or noninstructional personnel more than three times the average salary for teachers in the school district.

Be It Resolved by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

That the creation of Sections 8 and 9 of Article IX and the creation of a new section in Article XII of the State Constitution are agreed to and shall be submitted to the electors of this state for approval or rejection at the next general election or at an earlier special election specifically authorized by law for that purpose:

ARTICLE IX EDUCATION

SECTION 8. Funding for classroom instruction.—At least seventy percent of the funding received by each school district shall be expended for the purpose of supporting classroom instruction.

SECTION 9. Compensation for school administrative personnel and noninstructional personnel.—A school district may not provide compensation to its administrative personnel or noninstructional personnel in an amount greater than three times

the average salary of the teachers in that district.

ARTICLE XII

SCHEDULE

School district funding; limitation on compensation for administrative and noninstructional personnel.—

- (a) The requirement in Section 8 of Article IX that at least seventy percent of school funding received by each school district be expended for the purpose of supporting classroom instruction and this section shall be applicable beginning with the 2011-2012 school year.
- (b) The prohibition in Section 9 of Article IX against compensating school district administrative personnel or noninstructional personnel in an amount greater than three times the average salary of the teachers in the school district and this section shall be applicable beginning with the 2011-2012 school year.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the following statement be placed on the ballot:

ARTICLE XII

MINIMUM REQUIREMENT FOR SCHOOL DISTRICT FUNDING; LIMITATION ON COMPENSATION FOR ADMINISTRATIVE PERSONNEL AND NONINSTRUCTIONAL PERSONNEL.—Proposing an amendment to the State Constitution to require that at least 70 percent of school funding received by each school district be expended for the purpose of supporting classroom instruction. This amendment also prohibits a school district from compensating its administrative personnel or noninstructional personnel in an amount greater
