Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Administrative Trust Fund.-
(1) The Administrative Trust Fund is created within the

Executive Office of the Governor.
(2) The trust fund is established for use as a depository for funds to be used for management activities that are department-wide in nature and funded by indirect cost earnings or assessments against trust funds. Moneys to be credited to the trust fund include indirect cost reimbursements from grantors, administrative assessments against trust funds, interest earnings, and other appropriate administrative fees.
(3) In accordance with s. 19(f)(2), Article III of the State Constitution, the Administrative Trust Fund shall, unless terminated sooner, be terminated on July 1, 2014. Before its scheduled termination, the trust fund shall be reviewed as provided in s. $215.3206(1)$ and (2), Florida Statutes.

Section 2. This act shall take on the same date that SB 1238 or similar legislation takes effect, if such legislation is enacted in the same legislative session, or an extension thereof, and becomes law, but this act shall not take effect
