(c) If a firefighter, while engaged in the performance of his or her firefighter duties, is unlawfully and intentionally killed, is injured by an unlawful and intentional act of another

person and dies as a result of such injury, dies as a result of a fire which has been determined to have been caused by an act of arson, or subsequently dies as a result of injuries sustained therefrom, the sum of \$150,000, as adjusted pursuant to paragraph (i), shall be paid as provided in this section.

Notwithstanding any other provision of law, in no case shall the amount payable under this subsection be less than the actual amount stated therein.

Section 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law and shall apply to deaths of firefighters occurring on or after November 1, 2007.
