An act relating to a review under the Open Government Sunset Review Act; amending s. 39.0132, F.S., which provides an exemption from public-records requirements for certain information regarding a child held by a guardian ad litem; clarifying and reorganizing the exemption; removing the scheduled repeal of the exemption; providing an effective date.

Section 1. Paragraph (a) of subsection (4) of section 39.0132, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

39.0132 Oaths, records, and confidential information.-

15 (4) (a)1. All information obtained pursuant to this part in 16 the discharge of official duty by any judge, employee of the court, authorized agent of the department, correctional 17 18 probation officer, or law enforcement agent is confidential and 19 exempt from s. 119.07(1) and may not be disclosed to anyone 20 other than the authorized personnel of the court, the department 21 and its designees, correctional probation officers, law 2.2 enforcement agents, guardian ad litem, and others entitled under 23 this chapter to receive that information, except upon order of 24 the court.
