Section 1. Subsection (6) of section 166.031, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

166.031 Charter amendments.-

(6) Each municipality shall, by ordinance or charter provision, provide procedures for filling a vacancy in office caused by death, resignation, or removal from office. The Such ordinance or charter provision shall also provide procedures for filling a vacancy in candidacy caused by death, withdrawal, or removal from the ballot of a qualified candidate following the end of the qualifying period which leaves fewer than two candidates for an office. Notwithstanding any provisions adopted pursuant to this subsection, if a vacancy in candidacy is caused by the withdrawal or removal from the ballot of a qualified candidate for the second time in the same contest or by the death of such candidate, thereby leaving fewer than two candidates for the office, the remaining candidate shall be declared elected to the office without opposition and without the need for reopening the qualifying period and holding a
