A bill to be entitled

An act relating to the Legislature; amending s. 1 of chapter 2010-91, Laws of Florida; requiring the Legislature to enact the maps of the state legislative and congressional districts by a specified date in the year 2012; providing an effective date.

WHEREAS, the data and software to draw maps for the purpose of reapportionment are available to all members of the Legislature and the public, and

WHEREAS, Florida's schedule for apportioning legislative districts is one of the latest in the nation and was created before many of the advances in computing which allow maps to be drawn nearly instantaneously, and

WHEREAS, it could take months for federal and state agencies and the courts to approve all maps generated by the Legislature, and

WHEREAS, if the present timeline remains intact, the best case is that the citizens of the state will know their legislative districts only days before candidates are required to qualify, and

WHEREAS, the citizens of this state have the right to seek public office and have a reasonable time to qualify and run competitive races, and

WHEREAS, the citizens of this state should have the benefit of an orderly election cycle that allows sufficient time to review and decide on the candidate of their choice, NOW, THEREFORE,

(1) In accordance with subsection (b) of 35 Section 3 of Article III of the State Constitution and in lieu 36 of the date fixed therein, the 2012 Regular Session of the 37 Legislature shall convene on January 10, 2012. (2) By January 15, 2012, the Legislature shall enact the 38 39 maps for the state legislative and congressional districts which 40 are in accordance with the State Constitution and the United 41 States Constitution.
