The Committee on Banking and Insurance (Bogdanoff) recommended the following:

Senate Amendment to Amendment (488286) (with title amendment)

Between lines 58 and 59 insert:

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Section 2. Subsection (1) of section 440.12, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

440.12 Time for commencement and limits on weekly rate of compensation. -

(1) $\frac{1}{100}$ Compensation is not $\frac{1}{100}$ allowed for the first 7 days of the disability, except for benefits provided under for in s. 440.13. However, if the injury results in disability of

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more than 21 days, compensation shall be allowed from the commencement of the disability.

- (a) All weekly compensation payments, except for the first payment, shall be paid by check or, if authorized by the employee, on a prepaid card pursuant to paragraph (b) or deposited directly into the employee's account at a financial institution. As used in this subsection, the term "financial institution" means a financial institution as defined in s. 655.005(1)(h).
- (b) A carrier may use prepaid cards to deliver compensation to employees if the employee is:
- 1. Provided with at least one means of accessing his or her entire compensation payment once per week without incurring fees;
- 2. Provided with the terms and conditions of the program, including a description of any fees that may be assessed; and
- 3. Given the option of receiving compensation payments by direct deposit into his or her personal account at a financial institution.
- (c) Each carrier shall keep a record of all payments made under this subsection and the time and manner of such payments, and shall furnish these records, or a report based on these records, to the Bureau of Workers' Compensation Fraud upon request.
- Section 3. Paragraph (a) of subsection (1) of section 440.20, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:
- 440.20 Time for payment of compensation and medical bills; penalties for late payment.-
 - (1)(a) Unless it denies compensability or entitlement to



benefits, the carrier shall pay compensation directly to the employee as required by ss. 440.14, 440.15, and 440.16, in accordance with the obligations set forth in those such sections. If authorized by the employee, The carrier's obligation to pay compensation directly to the employee is satisfied when the carrier directly deposits, by electronic transfer or other means, compensation into the employee's account at a financial institution or onto a prepaid card in accordance with s. 440.12(1). As used in this paragraph, the term "financial institution" means a financial institution as defined in s. 655.005(1) (h). Compensation by direct deposit or through the use of a prepaid card is considered paid on the date the funds become available for withdrawal by the employee.

amending s. 440.12, F.S.; authorizing a worker's compensation insurance carrier to provide compensation payments through the use of prepaid cards under certain circumstances; requiring the carrier to maintain records of the payments made and the time and manner of the payments; amending s. 440.20, F.S.; providing that the obligation of a workers' compensation insurance carrier to pay compensation directly to an employee is satisfied by providing compensation through the use of a prepaid card;
