A bill to be entitled

An act relating to bullying or harassment; amending s. 1006.147, F.S.; requiring the Department of Education to create a stand-alone model policy designed to protect students from bullying and harassment; providing criteria; requiring that each public K-12 educational institution designate a school employee as counselor for any student suffering from bullying or harassment; requiring the Department of Education to approve and produce training materials; requiring the department to provide the materials at no cost to public K-12 educational institutions; providing an effective date.

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Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

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Section 1. Present subsections (8), (9), and (10) of section 1006.147, Florida Statutes, are renumbered as subsections (11), (12), and (13), respectively, and new subsections (8), (9), and (10) are added to that section, to read:

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1006.147 Bullying and harassment prohibited.-

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(8) The department shall create a stand-alone model policy designed to protect students from bullying or harassment. The model policy shall include:

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(a) A curriculum for pre-K through 12;

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(b) Instruction on awareness for parents and all school staff;

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(c) Investigation and resolution by the school

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administration or their designee of bullying or harassment that occurs off school grounds using nonschool technology, but has such negative impact on the school environment as to create a safety risk between students in conflict;

- (d) The prominent display of posters at schools and advertisements on school and district websites of the importance of Internet safety and how to report bullying and harassment; and
- (e) A procedure for immediate notification to parents of the consequences of bullying and harassment and the availability of counseling resources.
- (9) Each public K-12 educational institution shall designate a school employee to serve as a counselor for any student suffering from bullying or harassment.
- (10) The department shall approve and produce materials that are used to train designated school employees as counselors for students suffering from bullying or harassment. The department shall provide the materials to each public K-12 educational institution at no cost.
  - Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2011.
