The Committee on Environmental Preservation and Conservation (Dean) recommended the following:

## Senate Amendment (with title amendment)

Delete everything after the enacting clause and insert:

Section 1. Trucking Regulation Workgroup.-

- (1) There is created the Trucking Regulation Workgroup.
- (2) The workgroup shall consist of the following members, whose appointments to the workgroup must be made by August 1, 2011:
- (a) The Secretary of Transportation, or the secretary's designee.
  - (b) The executive director of the Department of Revenue, or

14	(c) The Secretary of Environmental Protection,	or	the
1.5	secretary's designee.		

- (d) The executive director of the Department of Law Enforcement, or the executive director's designee.
- (e) The executive director of the Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles, or the executive director's designee.
- (f) Three members, appointed by the Governor, who shall be owners or employees of trucking firms and represent small, medium, and large trucking firms, respectively.
- (g) One member who represents the Florida Trucking Association.
- (3) On or before October 1, 2011, the workgroup shall deliver to the Governor, the Speaker of the House of Representatives, and the President of the Senate a report concerning rules and regulations affecting trucking firms. The report shall provide legislative recommendations to address those concerns.
  - (4) The workgroup is abolished November 1, 2011. Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2011.
