Section 1. Random drug testing.-

- (1) As used in this section, the term "state financial assistance" includes, but is not limited to, temporary cash assistance, Medicaid, unemployment compensation, student financial assistance, public housing subsidies, and family-care assistance.
- (2) Any person who applies for or receives state financial assistance and has agreed to or is subject to random drug testing may not be randomly tested for drug use more than once in a 12-month period.

Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2011.
