An act relating to state memorials; creating s. 265.003, F.S.; providing legislative intent; establishing the Florida Veterans' Hall of Fame on the Plaza Level of the Capitol Building; providing for the Department of Veterans' Affairs to administer the Florida Veterans' Hall of Fame; authorizing the department to establish a nomination and selection process and an induction ceremony; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Section 265.003, Florida Statutes, is created to read:

265.003 Florida Veterans' Hall of Fame.

- (1) It is the intent of the Legislature to recognize and honor military veterans who, through their works and lives during or after military service, have made a significant contribution to this state.
- (2) (a) There is established the Florida Veterans' Hall of Fame. The Department of Management Services shall set aside an area on the Plaza Level of the Capitol Building, adjacent to the Medal of Honor Wall, and shall consult with the Department of Veterans' Affairs regarding the design and theme of the area.
- (b) The Florida Veterans' Hall of Fame shall be administered by the Department of Veterans' Affairs without the appropriation of state funds.
 - (c) Each person who is inducted into the Florida Veterans'

Hall of Fame shall have his or her name placed on a plaque displayed in the designated area of the Capitol.

- (3) (a) The Department of Veterans' Affairs shall accept nominations for persons to be considered for induction into the Florida Veterans' Hall of Fame and shall annually recommend to the Governor and Cabinet persons for induction.
- (b) In making such recommendations, the department shall give precedence to veterans who were born in Florida or adopted this state as their home state or base of operation and who have made a significant contribution to this state in civic, business, public service, or other pursuits.
- (4) The Department of Veterans' Affairs may establish selection criteria, specific time periods for the acceptance of nominations, a process for selecting nominees, and a formal induction ceremony to coincide with the annual commemoration of Veterans' Day.

Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2011.
