A bill to be entitled

An act relating to mentally deficient and mentally ill defendants; amending s. 916.106, F.S.; defining the term "traumatic brain injury"; revising the definition of the term "mental illness"; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Subsection (13) of section 916.106, Florida Statutes, is amended, and subsection (18) is added to that section, to read:

916.106 Definitions.—For the purposes of this chapter, the term:

- (13) "Mental illness" means an impairment of the emotional processes that exercise conscious control of one's actions, or of the ability to perceive or understand reality, which impairment substantially interferes with a defendant's ability to meet the ordinary demands of living and includes traumatic brain injury. For the purposes of this chapter, the term does not apply to defendants with only mental retardation or autism and does not include intoxication or conditions manifested only by antisocial behavior or substance abuse impairment.
- (18) "Traumatic brain injury" means a form of acquired brain injury that occurs when a sudden trauma causes damage to the brain and a severe change in emotional, behavioral, and cognitive functions.
 - Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2011.
