6 Section 4. Subsection (1) and paragraph (b) of subsection  
7 (3) of section 403.717, Florida Statutes, are amended to read:

8 403.717 Waste tire and lead-acid battery requirements.—

9 (1) For purposes of this section and ss. 403.718 and  
10 403.7185:

11 (a) "Department" means the Department of Environmental  
12 Protection.

13 (b)~~(i)~~ "Indoor" means within a structure that excludes  
14 rain and public access and would control air flows in the event  
15 of a fire.

16 (c)~~(h)~~ "Lead-acid battery" means a lead-acid battery  
17 designed for use in motor vehicles, vessels, and aircraft, and  
18 includes such batteries when sold new as a component part of a

19 motor vehicle, vessel, or aircraft, but not when sold to recycle  
20 components.

21 (d)~~(b)~~ "Motor vehicle" means an automobile, motorcycle,  
22 truck, trailer, semitrailer, truck tractor and semitrailer  
23 combination, or any other vehicle operated in this state, used  
24 to transport persons or property and propelled by power other  
25 than muscular power. The term does not include traction engines,  
26 road rollers, vehicles that run only upon a track, bicycles,  
27 mopeds, or farm tractors and trailers.

28 (e)~~(j)~~ "Processed tire" means a tire that has been treated  
29 mechanically, chemically, or thermally so that the resulting  
30 material is a marketable product or is suitable for proper  
31 disposal.

32 (f)~~(e)~~ "Tire" means a continuous solid or pneumatic rubber  
33 covering encircling the wheel of a motor vehicle.

34 (g)~~(k)~~ "Used tire" means a waste tire which has a minimum  
35 tread depth of 3/32 inch or greater and is suitable for use on  
36 a motor vehicle.

37 (h)~~(d)~~ "Waste tire" means a tire that has been removed  
38 from a motor vehicle and has not been retreaded or regrooved.  
39 The term includes, but is not limited to, used tires and  
40 processed tires. The term does not include solid rubber tires  
41 and tires that are inseparable from the rim.

42 (i)~~(e)~~ "Waste tire collection center" means a site where  
43 waste tires are collected from the public prior to being offered  
44 for recycling and where fewer than 1,500 tires are kept on the  
45 site on any given day.

46        (j)~~(f)~~ "Waste tire processing facility" means a site,  
47 permitted or approved by the department, where equipment is used  
48 to treat waste tires mechanically, chemically, or thermally so  
49 that the resulting material is a marketable product or is  
50 suitable for proper disposal. The term includes mobile waste  
51 tire processing equipment.

52        (k)~~(g)~~ "Waste tire site" means a site at which 1,500 or  
53 more waste tires are accumulated.

55        (b) It is unlawful for any person to:

56        1. Dispose of waste tires or processed tires in the state  
57 except at a permitted solid waste management facility.

58 Collection or storage of waste tires at a permitted waste tire  
59 processing facility or waste tire collection center prior to  
60 processing or use does not constitute disposal, provided that  
61 the collection and storage complies with rules established by  
62 the department.

63        2. Bale, wrap, or otherwise bundle together whole waste  
64 tires for purposes other than disposal pursuant to this section  
65 or facilitating transportation between waste tire processing  
66 facilities.
