Section 1. (1) The Office of Program Policy Analysis and Government Accountability (OPPAGA) shall conduct a study to determine the minimum amount of dollars per student needed to meet the requirement in Section 1 of Article IX of the State Constitution which declares: "Adequate provision shall be made by law for a uniform, efficient, safe, secure, and high quality system of free public schools that allows students to obtain a high quality education".

The minimum amount of dollars per kindergarten through grade 12 student shall be a statewide average calculated for basic education programs.

(3) OPPAGA shall submit a report of its findings and determination to the President of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of Representatives by December 1, 2012.
