A bill to be entitled

An act relating to the termination of gas or electric service; prohibiting any utility from terminating a senior citizen's or low-income family's gas or electric service for nonpayment on any day, or on the following 2 calendar days, during which the National Weather Service forecasts extreme temperatures in the area of the utility in which the senior citizen or low-income family resides; prohibiting any utility from terminating a senior citizen's or low-income family's gas or electric service for nonpayment on any day preceding a holiday or weekend during which the National Weather Service forecasts extreme temperatures in the area of the utility in which the senior citizen or low-income family resides; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. (1) A utility may not terminate a senior citizen's or low-income family's gas or electric service, if the service is the only source by which the residence is cooled or heated, for nonpayment of service on any day, or on the following 2 calendar days, during which the National Weather Service forecasts that the temperature is to reach 32° Fahrenheit or below or 95° Fahrenheit or above in the area of the utility in which the residence of the senior citizen or low-income family is located.

(2) A utility may not terminate a senior citizen's or low-

income family's gas or electric service, if the service is the only source by which the residence is cooled or heated, for nonpayment of service on any day immediately preceding a holiday or weekend during which the National Weather Service forecasts that the temperature is to reach 32° Fahrenheit or below or 95° Fahrenheit or above in the area of the utility in which the residence of the senior citizen or low-income family is located.

Section 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law.
