- (b) Elect to claim benefits under a health plan provided by his or her employer for the injuries suffered.
- (2) An employee exercising the option provided in this section must sign a notice under oath acknowledging that the employee is giving up the right to claim lost wages resulting from such injury and that the employer retains immunity from tort granted for compliance with this chapter, which means the right of such employee to bring an action against the employer to recover damages for injury or death is extinguished.
- (3) The election by an employee to receive benefits under a health plan shall not constitute a failure to secure compensation under s. 440.06 and shall not result in the loss of immunity by the employer.
