An act relating to the Pinellas Police Standards Council, Pinellas County; amending chapter 72-666, Laws of Florida, as amended; increasing a court cost to fund the council; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Paragraph (2) of subsection (k) of section 4 of chapter 72-666, Laws of Florida, as amended by chapter 97-333, Laws of Florida, is amended to read:

Section 4. Powers and duties.—In the performance of its duties and the execution of its functions under this act, the council shall have the following powers:

- (k) To provide for a centralized screening and information center on prospective law enforcement officers in Pinellas County, to be known as the Public Safety Applicant Screening Service (PSASS).
- (2) The council's annual budget shall be submitted to the Board of County Commissioners for their approval. The provisions of this section shall be funded by a \$3 \$2 court cost on all payable offenses, to be assessed by the circuit and county courts in Pinellas County on all contested and uncontested traffic cases, criminal and civil, excluding parking fines, bicycle violations, and pedestrian violations that are payable offenses. Additional funding may be secured by the council by assessing the law enforcement agencies a fee for the cost of screening the applicants.

Section 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law.
