Section 11. Subsection (48) is added to section 420.507, Florida Statutes, to read:

(48) Florida Housing may utilize up to 10 percent of its annual allocation of low income housing tax credits, allocation of non-taxable revenue bonds, and State Apartment Incentive Loan funds appropriated by the legislature and available to allocate by request for proposals or other competitive solicitation funding for high priority affordable housing projects, such as



housing to support economic development and job creation initiatives, housing for veterans and their families, and other special needs populations in communities throughout the state as determined by the corporation on an annual basis.
