HB 1203 2012

A bill to be entitled

An act relating to Palm Beach County; providing that the Health Care District of Palm Beach County shall be subject to the jurisdiction of the Office of Inspector General of Palm Beach County; specifying authority of the office; requiring the district to annually pay a certain amount of its budget for the preceding fiscal year to the office; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. (1) The Health Care District of Palm Beach
County, codified pursuant to section 189.429, Florida Statutes,
under chapter 2003-326, Laws of Florida, shall be subject to the
jurisdiction of the Office of Inspector General of Palm Beach
County, established pursuant to Article VIII, section 8.3 of the
Charter of Palm Beach County. The Office of Inspector General
shall exercise all authority relative to the district provided
to the office in the Palm Beach County Code as of the effective
date of this act and any additional authority agreed to by the
office and the district.

(2) The Health Care District of Palm Beach County shall annually and in advance pay to the Office of Inspector General of Palm Beach County the sum agreed to by the district and the office, which shall, unless requested by the Inspector General, be no less than 0.15 percent of the district's budget for the immediately preceding fiscal year.

Section 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law.
