Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

- Section 1. Section 11.065, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:
- 11.065 Claims against state; limitations; notice; expungement of records.—
- (1) A claim No claims against the state may not shall be presented to the Legislature more than 4 years after the cause for relief accrued. A Any claim presented after this time of limitation is shall be void and unenforceable.
- (2) All relief acts of the Legislature shall be for payment in full. No Further claims for relief $\underline{\text{may not}}$ shall be submitted to the Legislature in the future.
- (3) Notice shall be given as provided in s. 11.02 <u>before</u> prior to the introduction of any relief act <u>that</u> which provides for the payment of the claim from funds scheduled for distribution to a municipality from the revenue-sharing trust fund for municipalities.
- (4) Notwithstanding any other law, upon final passage of a legislative claim bill specifying that such action is warranted, the Department of Law Enforcement shall expunge the criminal
