Section 1. Subsection (18) is added to section 501.005, Florida Statutes, to read:

501.005 Consumer report security freeze.-

inmate in a correctional facility the opportunity to place a security freeze on his or her consumer report pursuant to this section. The department shall, at the request of the inmate, provide the appropriate forms to the inmate to initiate the security freeze process. All fees and expenses incurred in the application for a security freeze shall be paid by the inmate.

Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2012.
