The county commission of the county shall elect a
commissioner as that commission's representative on the board.
The commissioner must be a member of the county commission when
elected and for the full extent of his or her term.

24 2. The county commission of the county shall appoint a 25 citizen member to the board who is not a member of the county 26 commission but who is a resident and a qualified elector of that 27 county. Insofar as is practicable, the citizen member shall 28 represent the business and civic interests of the community.

3. The Governor shall appoint <u>two citizen members</u> a <u>citizen</u> member to the board who <u>are not members</u> is not a member of the county commission but who <u>are residents and qualified electors</u> <u>is a resident and a qualified elector</u> of that county.

(e) The Governor shall appoint <u>six</u> two members to the board who are residents and qualified electors in the area served by the authority <u>but who are not residents of the same county and</u> also not residents of the county in which the district secretary who was appointed pursuant to paragraph (c) is a resident. <u>No</u> <u>more than two voting members appointed by the Governor shall be</u> from the same county.
