17	supervision of the board of county commissioners or the court
18	may provide probation services for offenders sentenced by the
19	county court.
20	(b) If the board of county commissioners or court has
21	established a misdemeanor probation program for defendants
22	convicted of a misdemeanor for possession of a controlled
23	substance or drug paraphernalia under chapter 893, probation
24	supervision services that include substance abuse education and
25	intervention services shall be provided by a substance abuse
26	service provider licensed under chapter 397 unless the provider
27	is exempt from such licensure under s. 397.405.
