HB 443 2012

A bill to be entitled

An act relating to school wellness and physical education policies; amending s. 1003.453, F.S.; providing requirements for training in cardiopulmonary resuscitation as part of basic first-aid training encouraged in the school districts; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Subsection (4) of section 1003.453, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

1003.453 School wellness and physical education policies; nutrition guidelines.—

(4) School districts are encouraged to provide basic training in first aid, including cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR), for all students, beginning in grade 6 and every 2 years thereafter. As part of the training in CPR, which is based on a program that is nationally recognized and uses the most current national evidence-based emergency cardiovascular care guidelines, students shall learn and practice the psychomotor skills associated with performing CPR at least one time prior to high school graduation. Psychomotor skills are learned through hands-on practice and skills testing which support cognitive learning. Private and public partnerships for providing training or necessary funding are encouraged.

Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2012.
