Section 877.28, Florida Statutes, is created to 16 read: 17 877.28 Lighters and matches; minors.— (1) As used in this section, the term: 18 19 "Lighter" means a portable device that uses a 20 flammable gas or liquid to provide a naked flame or a red-hot 21 filament to light cigarettes, cigars, pipes, grills, fireplaces, 22 campfires, or campfire stoves. A lighter may include, but is not 23 limited to, a custom lighter, cigar lighter, pipe lighter, 24 candle lighter, outdoor grill lighter, camping lighter, novelty lighter, table lighter, butane lighter, and any other self-25 26 contained portable flame-producing device. 27 "Matches" means a lighter consisting of a thin piece 28 of wood or cardboard tipped with a combustible chemical that

will ignite with friction. Matches may include, but are not limited to, safety matches, strike-anywhere matches, storm matches, Bengal matches, a matchbook, and a matchbox.

- (2) It is unlawful for a minor to purchase a lighter or matches.
- (3) It is unlawful for any retailer to sell or give a lighter or matches to a minor.
- (4) (a) A retailer must verify the age of a person who is purchasing a lighter or matches.
- (b) Lighters and matches must be located by a retailer so as to limit direct access to them by a customer before purchase.
- (c) Each retailer selling lighters or matches must post a sign stating, "The sale of lighters and matches to a person under the age of 18 is prohibited."
 - (5) A person who violates this section commits:
- (a) For a first violation, a misdemeanor of the second degree, punishable as provided in s. 775.082 or s. 775.083.
- (b) For a second or subsequent violation, a misdemeanor of the first degree, punishable as provided in s. 775.082 or s. 775.083.
 - Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2012.
