House Amendment 1 - 831651 (body with title)

## II. Summary of Amendments Contained in Message:

**House Amendment 1** is a delete-all that differs from the Senate bill in the following ways. It:

- postpones the date that an interlocal agreement must be adopted from December 1, 2012, to May 1, 2013;
- provides that St. Lucie County be compensated for infrastructure investments made in the area being transferred;
- establishes 2013-14 as a base year to calculate certain revenue transfers;
- provides for a gradual transfer of tax and assessment revenues from the area being incorporated into Martin County to St. Lucie County over a ten year period rather than a five year period;
- provides a distribution formula for each county to share tax and assessment revenues in a year when revenues exceed the base amount by three percent; and
- establishes that distributions to St. Lucie County shall occur within 30 days after the beginning of each calendar year.
