in the English language, in which 25 percent of the content is news and editorial in nature, and whose total minimum circulation of greater than 2,500 is biannually audited and certified in an affidavit by an independent third-party auditor approved by the Community Papers of Florida, the Florida Community Paper Advertising Network, the Florida Press Association, or a similarly sanctioned organization recognized by the newspaper industry or entered or qualified to be admitted and entered as periodicals matter at a post office in the county

where published, for sale to the public generally, available to the public generally for the publication of official or other notices and customarily containing information of a public character or of interest or of value to the residents or owners of property in the county where published, or of interest or of value to the general public.

Section 2. Section 50.031, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

50.031 Newspapers in which legal notices and process may be published.-No notice or publication required to be published in a newspaper in the nature of or in lieu of process of any kind, nature, character or description provided for under any law of the state, whether heretofore or hereafter enacted, and whether pertaining to constructive service, or the initiating, assuming, reviewing, exercising or enforcing jurisdiction or power, by any court in this state, or any notice of sale of property, real or personal, for taxes, state, county or municipal, or sheriff's, quardian's or administrator's or any sale made pursuant to any judicial order, decree or statute or any other publication or notice pertaining to any affairs of the state, or any county, municipality or other political subdivision thereof, shall be deemed to have been published in accordance with the statutes providing for such publication, unless the same shall have been published for the prescribed period of time required for such publication, in a newspaper which at the time of such publication shall have been in existence for 1 year, in which 25 percent of the content is news and editorial in nature, and whose total minimum circulation of greater than 2,500 is biannually audited and certified in an affidavit
