5 (4) (a) Except as provided in paragraph (b), each report
6 required by this section must contain:

7 1. The full name, address, and occupation, if any of each
8 person who has made one or more contributions to or for such
9 committee or candidate within the reporting period, together
10 with the amount and date of such contributions. For
11 corporations, the report must provide as clear a description as
12 practicable of the principal type of business conducted by the
13 corporation. However, if the contribution is \$100 or less or is
14 from a relative, as defined in s. 112.312, provided that the
15 relationship is reported, the occupation of the contributor or
16 the principal type of business need not be listed.

17 2. The name and address of each political committee from
18 which the reporting committee or the candidate received, or to
19 which the reporting committee or candidate made, any transfer of
20 funds, together with the amounts and dates of all transfers.

21 3. Each loan for campaign purposes to or from any person
22 or political committee within the reporting period, together
23 with the full names, addresses, and occupations, and principal
24 places of business, if any, of the lender and endorsers, if any,
25 and the date and amount of such loans.

26 4. A statement of each contribution, rebate, refund, or
27 other receipt not otherwise listed under subparagraphs 1.
28 through 3.

29 5. The total sums of all loans, in-kind contributions, and
30 other receipts by or for such committee or candidate during the
31 reporting period. The reporting forms shall be designed to
32 elicit separate totals for in-kind contributions, loans, and
33 other receipts.

34 6. The full name and address of each person to whom
35 expenditures have been made by or on behalf of the committee or
36 candidate within the reporting period; the amount, date, and
37 purpose of each such expenditure; and the name and address of,
38 and office sought by, each candidate on whose behalf such
39 expenditure was made. However, expenditures made from the petty
40 cash fund provided by s. 106.12 need not be reported
41 individually.

42 7. The full name and address of each person to whom an
43 expenditure for personal services, salary, or reimbursement for
44 authorized expenses as provided in s. 106.021(3) has been made

45 and which is not otherwise reported, including the amount, date,
46 and purpose of such expenditure. However, expenditures made from
47 the petty cash fund provided for in s. 106.12 need not be
48 reported individually. Receipts for reimbursement for authorized
49 expenditures shall be retained by the treasurer along with the
50 records for the campaign account.

51 8. The total amount withdrawn and the total amount spent
52 for petty cash purposes pursuant to this chapter during the
53 reporting period.

54 9. The total sum of expenditures made by such committee or
55 candidate during the reporting period.

56 10. The amount and nature of debts and obligations owed by
57 or to the committee or candidate, which relate to the conduct of
58 any political campaign.

59 11. Transaction information for each credit card purchase.
60 Receipts for each credit card purchase shall be retained by the
61 treasurer with the records for the campaign account.

62 12. The amount and nature of any separate interest-bearing
63 accounts or certificates of deposit and identification of the
64 financial institution in which such accounts or certificates of
65 deposit are located.

66 13. The primary purposes of an expenditure made indirectly
67 through a campaign treasurer pursuant to s. 106.021(3) for goods
68 and services such as communications media placement or
69 procurement services, campaign signs, insurance, and other
70 expenditures that include multiple components as part of the
71 expenditure. The primary purpose of an expenditure shall be that

72 purpose, including integral and directly related components,
73 that comprises 80 percent of such expenditure.

74 (b) Multiple uniform contributions of less than \$250 per
75 calendar year collected by an organization that is the
76 affiliated sponsor of a political committee may be reported by
77 the political committee in an aggregate amount, listing the
78 number of contributors together with the amount contributed by
79 each and the total amount contributed during the reporting
80 period. The identity of each person making a uniform
81 contribution must be reported to the department in the same form
82 as other contributors by July 1 of each calendar year or no
83 later than the 60th day immediately preceding the primary
84 election.

85 (c) The filing officer shall make available to any
86 candidate or committee a reporting form which the candidate or
87 committee may use to indicate contributions received by the
88 candidate or committee but returned to the contributor before
89 deposit.
