Amendment (with title amendment)

6 Remove everything after the enacting clause and insert:

7 Section 1. Subsection (16) is added to section 633.0215,
8 Florida Statutes, to read:

9 633.0215 Florida Fire Prevention Code.—

10 (16) (a) For one-story or two-story structures that are
11 less than 10,000 square feet, whose occupancy is defined in the
12 Florida Building Code and the Florida Fire Prevention Code as
13 business or mercantile, a fire official shall enforce the wall
14 fire-rating provisions for occupancy separation as defined in
15 the Florida Building Code.

16 (b) A structure, located on property that is classified
17 for ad valorem purposes as agricultural, which is part of a
18 farming or ranching operation, in which the occupancy is limited
19 to no more than 35 persons, and which is not used by the public

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20 for direct sales or as an educational outreach facility, is
21 exempt from the Florida Fire Prevention Code, including the
22 national codes and Life Safety Code incorporated by reference.
23 This paragraph does not include structures used for residential
24 or assembly occupancies, as defined in the Florida Fire
25 Prevention Code.

26 Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2013.
