6 Between lines 769 and 770 of the amendment, insert:

7 The Legislature ratifies and approves the actions of the  
 8 Board of Trustees of the Internal Improvement Trust Fund  
 9 regarding lease numbers 1447, 1971S, 3420, and 3543, and lease  
 10 numbers 3422 and 1935/1935-S as approved on January 23, 2013,  
 11 subject to the terms and conditions established by the board of  
 12 trustees as approved on January 23, 2013.

13 The Legislature finds that the decision to authorize the  
 14 use of board of trustees-owned uplands and the use of those  
 15 lands as set forth in the leases is not contrary to the public  
 16 interest; that it is in the public interest to waive the  
 17 competitive bid process; that the leases are not standard  
 18 agricultural leases; and that such leases should be amended on  
 19 the terms and conditions as approved by the board of trustees.

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20 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the Legislature  
21 finds that the lease amendments and extensions approved by the  
22 board of trustees are necessary for Everglades restoration  
23 purposes, are in the public interest, and provide the greatest  
24 combination of benefits to the public.
