(3) AFTERCARE SERVICES.-

(a) Aftercare services are available to a young adult who has reached 18 years of age but is not yet 23 years of age and is:

1. Not in foster care.

2. Temporarily not receiving financial assistance under

subsection (2) to pursue postsecondary education.

15	2. Mental health services and substance abuse counseling.		
16	3. Life skills classes, including credit management and		
17	preventive health activities.		
18	4. Parenting classes.		
19	5. Job and career skills training.		
20	6. Counselor consultations.		
21	7. Temporary financial assistance for necessities,		
22	including, but not limited to, education supplies,		
23	transportation expenses, security deposits for rent and		
24	4 <u>utilities, furnishings, household goods, and other basic living</u>		
25	expenses.		
26	8. Financial literacy skills training.

28	The specific services to be provided under this paragraph shall		
29	be determined by an assessment of the young adult and may be		
30	provided by the community-based care provider or through		
31	referrals in the community.		
32	(c) Temporary assistance provided to prevent homelessness		
33	shall be provided as expeditiously as possible and within the		
34	limitations defined by the department.
