Section 1. Subsection (16) is added to section 633.0215, Florida Statutes, to read:

633.0215 Florida Fire Prevention Code. -

- (16) (a) A local government having a population of fewer than 30,000 is exempt from any minimum fire-flow requirements for one- or two-story residential dwellings in the Florida Fire Prevention Code, including the national codes incorporated by reference.
- (b) A business located in a one-, two-, or three-story building is exempt from any 2-hour or longer fire-rated wall requirement in the Florida Fire Prevention Code, including the national codes incorporated by reference.
- (c) An agricultural operation that employs fewer than 50 full-time employees and that is not used by the public for direct sales or as an educational outreach facility is exempt from the Florida Fire Prevention Code, including the national codes and Life Safety Code incorporated by reference.

Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2013.
