6 (19) "Reasonable offset for use" means the number of miles
 7 attributable to a consumer up to the date of a settlement
 8 agreement or arbitration hearing, whichever occurs first,
 9 multiplied by the base selling or sale purchase price of the
 10 vehicle as reflected on the purchase invoice, exclusive of
 11 taxes, government fees, and dealer fees, or in the case of a
 12 lease, the agreed upon value as reflected in the lease agreement
 13 and divided by 120,000, except in the case of a recreational
 14 vehicle, in which event it shall be divided by 60,000.
