A bill to be entitled

An act relating to the Florida Communications Fraud Act; amending s. 817.034, F.S.; establishing a statute of limitations for criminal and civil causes of actions under the act; specifying circumstances that toll the statute of limitations; amending s. 921.0022, F.S.; increasing the severity of a violation of the act for purposes of the criminal punishment code; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

2.1

Section 1. Paragraph (d) is added to subsection (4) of section 817.034, Florida Statutes, to read:

817.034 Florida Communications Fraud Act.-

16 (4) OFFENSES.—

(d) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, a criminal action, civil action, or proceeding under this act may be commenced at any time within 5 years after the cause of action accrues; however, in a criminal action under this act, the period of limitation does not run during any time when the defendant is continuously absent from the state or is without a reasonably ascertainable place of abode or work within the state, but in no case shall this extend the period of limitation otherwise applicable by more than 1 year. If a criminal action, civil action, or other proceeding is brought or intervened in to punish, prevent, or restrain any violation of this act, the running of the period of limitation prescribed by this subsection with respect to any cause of action arising under
