Section 1. Paragraph (a) of subsection (2) of section 376.30711, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:
376.30711 Preapproved Site rehabilitation, effective March 29, 1995.—

(2) (a) Competitive bidding pursuant to this section <u>is</u> shall not be subject to the requirements of s. 287.055. The department <u>may</u> is authorized to use competitive bid procedures or negotiated contracts for preapproving all costs and rehabilitation procedures for site-specific rehabilitation projects through performance-based contracts. Site rehabilitation shall be conducted according to the priority ranking order established pursuant to s. 376.3071(5).

Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2013.
