Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

student enters grade 7.

Section 1. Beginning with the 2013-2014 school year, the parent or guardian of a student entering grade 6 shall be provided information on the availability of vaccination against human papillomavirus as recommended by the Advisory Committee on Immunization Practices of the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention. Such information shall be approved by the Department of Health for dissemination by the Department of Education. The information must, at a minimum, include the connection between human papillomavirus and cervical cancer as well as other cancers and diseases. The information must also notify the parent or guardian that a vaccine is available to help prevent human papillomavirus infection and that the advisory committee recommends that the vaccination process be completed before the

Section 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law.
