4 5 Remove everything after the enacting clause and insert: Section 1. Subsections (3) and (4) of section 409.16713, Florida Statutes, are amended to read:

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409.16713 Allocation of funds for community-based care lead agencies.—

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(3) Beginning in the $\underline{2013-2014}$ $\underline{2011-2012}$ state fiscal year, $\underline{90}$ 75 percent of the recurring core services funding for each community-based care lead agency shall be based on the prior year recurring base of core services funds and $\underline{10}$ $\underline{25}$ percent shall be based on the equity allocation model.

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(4) Except as otherwise specified in the General

Appropriations Act For the 2011-2012 state fiscal year, any new core services funds shall be allocated based on the equity

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allocation model. Such allocations shall be proportional to the proportion of funding based on the equity model and allocated only to the community-based care lead agency contracts where the current funding proportion is less than the proportion of funding based on the equity model.

Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2013.
