1 A bill to be entitled 2 An act relating to public school funding; creating s. 3 1011.645, F.S.; creating the poverty-based categorical 4 fund; providing criteria for determining the poverty 5 level of each school district; requiring the 6 Department of Education to establish a threshold level 7 for school district eligibility for funds; providing 8 for the allocation of funds as prescribed in the 9 General Appropriations Act; providing requirements for the use of funds; requiring the State Board of 10 Education to adopt rules; providing an effective date. 11

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Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

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Section 1. Section 1011.645, Florida Statutes, is created to read:

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## 1011.645 Poverty-based categorical fund.—

(1) There is created a poverty-based categorical fund to provide supplemental funds to school districts based on the relative poverty level in each school district. The poverty level shall be determined by the number of students receiving free or reduced-price meals under the National School Lunch Program based upon computation by the Department of Education. The department shall establish a threshold poverty level for school district eligibility above which a school district qualifies for poverty-based categorical funds. These funds shall be allocated annually to eligible school districts in an amount prescribed by the Legislature in the General Appropriations Act

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- (2) Poverty-based categorical funds shall be used by school districts for class size reduction, intervention for atrisk kindergarten through grade 3 students, and reading improvement programs according to identified needs of individual school districts and rules adopted by the State Board of Education.
  - Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2013.
