Remove everything after the enacting clause and insert:

Section 1. Review and evaluation of local firefighter and police officer pension plans.—

- (1) The Department of Management Services shall conduct a review and evaluation of firefighter pension plans established under chapter 175, Florida Statutes, and police officer pension plans established under chapter 185, Florida Statutes. The review and evaluation shall be comprehensive in its scope and, at a minimum, must:
- (a) Discuss the role and responsibilities of the local boards of trustees, including, in general, how the boards are funded and how the boards operate.

- (b) Identify the minimum benefits and minimum standards that must be met in order for a plan to qualify for insurance premium tax dollars.
- (c) Identify when insurance premium tax dollars may be used to fund firefighter or police officer pension plan benefits.
- (d) Identify the criteria used by the Division of

 Retirement within the Department of Management Services to

 determine whether a firefighter or police officer pension plan
 will be denied access to insurance premium tax dollars.
- (e) Provide a summary of the interpretations provided by the Division of Retirement within the Department of Management Services regarding the use or restrictions on the use of insurance premium tax dollars.
- (f) Determine whether rulemaking authority should be granted to the Department of Management Services.
- (g) Provide recommendations for the restructuring,
 distribution, and use of insurance premium tax dollars to fund
 firefighter pension plans established under chapter 175, Florida
 Statutes, and police officer pension plans established under
 chapter 185, Florida Statutes.
- (2) The Department of Management Services may obtain all relevant data, information, and assistance from state agencies, local governments, or political subdivisions thereof on any matter within their knowledge or control.
- (3) The Department of Management Services shall consult with interested stakeholders to solicit information and input regarding the review and evaluation of the firefighter pension plans established under chapter 175, Florida Statutes, and

police officer pension plans established under chapter 185,

Florida Statutes. Consultation with stakeholders may be

accomplished through interviews, surveys, or any other manner
deemed appropriate by the department.

(4) By December 31, 2013, the Department of Management
Services shall submit a report of its findings and
recommendations to the Governor, the President of the Senate,
the Speaker of the House of Representatives, and the chairs of
the appropriations committees and of the appropriate substantive
committees of the Senate and the House of Representatives.
