A repair made in the tread shoulder or belt edge area 23 of the tire; 24 2. A puncture that has not been sealed or patched on the 25 inside and repaired with a cured rubber stem through to the 26 outside of the tire; 27 3. A repair to the sidewall or bead area of the tire; or
