House Resolution 1 2 A resolution celebrating April 2013 as "Jazz 3 Appreciation Month" in the State of Florida. 4 5 WHEREAS, with roots in the African-American community and 6 created in the early 20th century, jazz played a major role in 7 the cultural and social history of America, and 8 WHEREAS, Florida Agricultural and Mechanical University and 9 Florida State University have jazz studies departments within 10 their respective schools of music that teach and train the next generations of jazz musicians, and 11 12 WHEREAS, B Sharps Jazz Club and several other venues in 13 Florida's capital city provide opportunities for students to 14 hone their skills and for the community to experience live jazz 15 music, and WHEREAS, to increase jazz awareness in the state, the 16 17 Florida Jazz Initiative exposes youth to the sound and history 18 of this exceptional genre and presents and supports world-class 19 jazz musicians who are native to Florida, and WHEREAS, the month of April is the birth month of such jazz 20 legends as Duke Ellington, Ella Fitzgerald, Herbie Hancock, 21 22 Billie Holiday, Charles Mingus, Gerry Mulligan, Tito Puente, and 23 Bessie Smith, and 24 WHEREAS, the Smithsonian Institution's National Museum of 25 American History, along with partners including the National 26 Endowment for the Arts, the National Association of Music 27 Education, and the Grammy Foundation have designated April as "Jazz Appreciation Month" to draw greater public attention to 28 Page 1 of 2
