17	the students assigned to that teacher, and the remaining portion									
18	shall be based on factors identified in district-determined,									
19	state-approved evaluation system plans.									
20	(2) The student performance data used in the performance									
21	evaluation of nonclassroom instructional personnel shall be									
22	based on student outcome data that reflects the actual									
23	contribution of such personnel to the performance of the									
24	students assigned to the individual in the individual's areas of
