6 Remove everything after the enacting clause and insert:

7 Section 1. Subsection (5) of section 258.007, Florida  
 8 Statutes, is amended to read:

9 258.007 Powers of division.—

10 (5) (a) The division, in cooperation with the Division of  
 11 Historical Resources of the Department of State, is authorized  
 12 and empowered to select and designate, within the state park  
 13 system, sites of historic interest and value and to erect and  
 14 maintain appropriate signs or markers indicating said sites upon  
 15 public property as well as upon private property where  
 16 permission is obtained. For a historical monument indicating a  
 17 site of historical interest and value, the division may not

18 erect such a monument unless the division first publishes for  
19 one week a public notice of the division's decision to erect a  
20 historical monument at a site of historic interest and value in  
21 a newspaper of general circulation within the county or counties  
22 where the site is located. If there is no newspaper of general  
23 circulation within such county or counties, then the division  
24 shall post a notice at each entrance to the site of historical  
25 interest and value where the proposed historical monument is to  
26 be erected. The Department of Environmental Protection may adopt  
27 rules specifying the content of the public notice. As used in  
28 this subsection, the term "historical monument" means a  
29 permanent structure erected to commemorate a person or important  
30 event of historical significance to the state, a region of the  
31 state, or local community.

32 (b) Within 30 days from the date the public notice appears  
33 in a newspaper of general circulation or is posted, as provided  
34 in this subsection, any person may submit a request, in writing,  
35 to the Board of Trustees of the Internal Improvement Trust Fund  
36 asking the board to review the division's decision to erect a  
37 historical monument. If the board receives such a request  
38 within the 30-day period, then the board, within 90 days of  
39 receiving the first request, must, at a regularly scheduled  
40 meeting of the board, vote on whether to approve the division's  
41 decision to erect the historical monument. The board may only  
42 approve such a decision by the division upon a majority vote of  
43 the members of the board.
