6 Remove lines 1124-1125 and insert:

7 \$175,000 or more and an estimated annual countrywide standard
8 premium of \$1 million or more for workers' compensation.
9 Provisions within a retrospective rating plan authorizing
10 negotiated premiums are exempt from s. 627.072(1). Such plans
11 and associated forms must be filed by a rating organization and
12 approved by the office. However, a premium negotiated between
13 the employer and the insurer pursuant to an approved
14 retrospective rating plan is not subject to this part.
