A bill to be entitled  
 An act relating to package stores; repealing s.  
 565.04, F.S., relating to restrictions on the sale by  
 certain licensed alcoholic beverage vendors of  
 merchandise other than specifically authorized types  
 of merchandise and restrictions on direct access to  
 such a vendor's place of business; amending s. 402.82,  
 F.S.; conforming provisions; defining the term  
 "package store"; prohibiting electronic benefits  
 transfer cards from being used or accepted at  
 locations operated as a package store; providing an  
 effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Section 565.04, Florida Statutes, is repealed.

Section 2. Paragraph (a) of subsection (4) of section  
 402.82, Florida Statutes, is amended, to read:

402.82 Electronic benefits transfer program.—

(4) Use or acceptance of an electronic benefits transfer  
 card is prohibited at the following locations or for the  
 following activities:

(a) An establishment licensed under the Beverage Law to  
 sell distilled spirits as a vendor and that:

1. Is restricted as to the types of products that can be  
 sold under s. ss. 565.04 and 565.045; ~~or~~

27        2. Operates as a bottle club as defined in s. 561.01; or  
28        3. Operates as a package store. For purposes of this  
29        subparagraph, the term "package store" means a vendor licensed  
30        under s. 565.02(1)(a) that is devoted exclusively to the sale of  
31        alcoholic beverages sold only in sealed containers for  
32        consumption off the premises and in which the sale of any other  
33        merchandise is merely incidental to the sale of alcoholic  
34        beverages.

35        Section 3. This act shall take effect July 1, 2014.
