> Section 2. Subsection (3) of section 448.110, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

448.110 State minimum wage; annual wage adjustment; enforcement.-

(3) Effective January 1, 2015 May 2, 2005, employers shall pay employees a minimum wage at an hourly rate of \$10.00 \$6.15 for all hours worked in Florida. An employer may not pay an



employee at a rate less than the state minimum wage Only those individuals entitled to receive the federal minimum wage under the federal Fair Labor Standards Act and its implementing regulations shall be eligible to receive the state minimum wage pursuant to s. 24, Art. X of the State Constitution and this section. The provisions of ss. 213 and 214 of the federal Fair Labor Standards Act, as interpreted by applicable federal regulations and implemented by the Secretary of Labor, are incorporated herein.

> An act relating to wages; amending s. 34.01, F.S.; expanding the original jurisdiction of county courts; amending s. 448.110, F.S.; increasing the state minimum wage as of a specified date; prohibiting an employer from paying an employee less than the minimum wage; removing a provision that limits an employee's eligibility to receive a minimum wage; removing a provision that incorporates by reference the federal Fair Labor Standards Act; creating s. 448.115, F.S.; defining the term
