A bill to be entitled

An act relating to off-highway vehicles; amending ss. 261.03 and 317.0003, F.S.; revising the definitions of the terms "ATV" and "ROV" for purposes of provisions relating to registration and use of off-highway vehicles; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Subsections (2) and (8) of section 261.03, Florida Statutes, are amended to read:

261.03 Definitions.—As used in this chapter, the term:

- (2) "ATV" means any motorized off-highway or all-terrain vehicle 50 inches or less in width, which has having a dry weight of 1,200 pounds or less, is designed to travel on three or more nonhighway tires, and is manufactured for recreational use by one or more persons having a seat designed to be straddled by the operator and handlebars for steering control, and intended for use by a single operator with no passenger.
- (8) "ROV" means any motorized recreational off-highway vehicle 65 64 inches or less in width, which has having a dry weight of 2,000 pounds or less, is designed to travel on four or more nonhighway tires, having nonstraddle seating and a steering wheel, and is manufactured for recreational use by one or more persons. The term "ROV" does not include a golf cart as defined in ss. 320.01 and 316.003(68) or a low-speed vehicle as defined

Section 2. Subsections (1) and (9) of section 317.0003, Florida Statutes, are amended to read:

317.0003 Definitions.—As used in this chapter, the term:

- (1) "ATV" means any motorized off-highway or all-terrain vehicle 50 inches or less in width, which has having a dry weight of 1,200 pounds or less, is designed to travel on three or more nonhighway tires, and is manufactured for recreational use by one or more persons having a seat designed to be straddled by the operator and handlebars for steering control, and intended for use by a single operator and with no passenger.
- vehicle 65 64 inches or less in width, which has having a dry weight of 2,000 pounds or less, is designed to travel on four or more nonhighway tires, having nonstraddle seating and a steering wheel, and is manufactured for recreational use by one or more persons. The term "ROV" does not include a golf cart as defined in ss. 320.01 and 316.003(68) or a low-speed vehicle as defined in s. 320.01.
 - Section 3. This act shall take effect July 1, 2014.
